### **Greater Things**

#### **Seeing Double**

**2 Kings 2:1-15 (page 250 in the Auditorium Bible)**

**When one door closes, another opens!**

#### **Be a Faithful Servant**

3 times Elijah told Elisha, "Stay here"  
3 times Elisha responded, "I will not leave you" (verses 2, 4, 6)

How committed are you to where God has you today?

Jesus taught, "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things" (Matthew 25:21).

#### **Ask Difficult Things**

"Elijah said to Elisha, 'Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you?' 'Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit,' Elisha replied. 'You have asked a difficult thing,' Elijah said" (verses 9-10).

God turns grief into joy and sacrifices into blessings.

It is not that God owes any of us anything, but we should ask God, "How can you receive glory through the sacrifices I've experienced?" Consider Abraham, Joseph, Daniel, Jesus...

"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you" (Matthew 7:7).

#### **Expect Greater Things**

"Elijah said, 'yet if you see me when I am taken from you, it will be yours'" (verse 10).

"He took the cloak that had fallen from Elijah and struck the water with it. 'Where now is the Lord, the God of Elijah?'" (verse 14).
