#### **Is Jesus Really God?**

**Isaiah 53:1-6 (page 505 in the Auditorium Bible)**

**By the testimony of Jesus, He is either God, or a fraud. There is no logical middle ground.**

#### **What was said before Jesus? - Prophecy**

In the Garden of Eden – *“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel”* (Genesis 3:15).

To Abraham – *“I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you”* (Genesis 12:3).

Through Isaiah - *“He was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed”* (Isaiah 53:5).


## CHILDREN

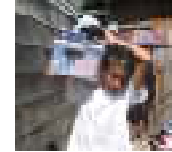
