The next **Prayer Night** is **Tuesday, March 5**, at **7 PM**. Join us for an evening of prayer at the Church Office. **Open to all**.

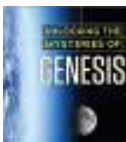


Daylight Savings begins on **March 10. Spring Forward!**
