To Be Greater - Sacrifice

John 15:9-17 (page 737 in the Auditorium Bible)

The greatest love is measured by sacrifice.

"Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends" (verse 13).

Love Sacrifices for a Greater Joy.
