What Now?

The disciples are now beyond Easter Sunday. The tomb is empty. What now? Can we learn from the disciples what we should do now in the week following Easter Sunday?

Go back to what you know.

"I'm going out to fish," Simon Peter told them, and they said, 'We'll go with you.' So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing" (John 21:3).

"You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness" (Ephesians 4:22-24).

Have you gone back to your old life?

Spend time with Jesus.

"Jesus said to them, 'Come and have breakfast.' None of the disciples dared ask him, 'Who are you?' They knew it was the Lord. Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish" (John 21:12-13).

"When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus" (Acts 4:13).

Have you spent time with Jesus?

Be restored to Jesus.

"When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, 'Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?'" (John 21:15).

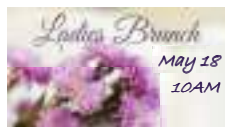
