Mark 4:3-20 (page 684 in the Auditorium Bible)

3 Traits of people who grow through Rocky Soil They Have Deep Roots

"It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow" (verse 5).

Signs of short-term faith:

Borrowed Faith – Timothy from his Mother and Grandmother (2 Timothy 1:5)

Acting on impulse – Simon the Sorcerer (Acts 8:14-23)

Emotionalism – the 1,000's who left Jesus (John 6:27)

Focus on externals – whitewashed tombs (Matthew 23-27)
