Getting Out Alive Right Where God Wants You

Genesis 13 (page 8-9 in the Auditorium Bible)

How do you know you are right where God wants you?

You can Call on God's Presence

"There Abram called on the name of the Lord" (verse 4).
"There he built an altar to the Lord" (verse 18).

God knows where you are! Psalm 139:7-10
God determined your times and places! Acts 17:26
Nothing in the world can separate you from God: prison, cave, furnace, lion's den, or being inside of a whale!

Are you building an altar right where you are?

You can Count God's Blessings

Abraham was still waiting to be a father, but we read, *"Abram had become very wealthy in livestock and in silver and gold"* (verse 2).

Are you so focused on what you don't have, or have lost, that you forget to give thanks for what you possess?

You can Accept God's Will

Abram put the future of his family in the hands of his nephew Lot.
"If you go to the left, I'll go to the right; if you go to the right, I'll go to the left" (verse 9).
